SUBJECT: POLLWORKERS NEEDED

At 7:00 a.m. on Tuesday, November 4, 2008, all of the polling places in San Bernardino County will be opened for voters to cast their ballots in the very important Presidential General Election. At the present time, there are still many openings throughout the County for persons willing to help out by performing this important civic duty. Bilingual volunteers (fluent in English and Spanish) are especially needed.

Poll workers attend special 2-hour training classes to assist them in doing their job and familiarizing themselves with the election procedures.

- No experience is required—you will be trained.
- Poll workers must be a citizen of the United States and a registered voter.
- Earn \$135 as an Inspector, plus \$30 for a 3-hour training class; or \$100 as a Clerk, plus \$15 for a 2-hour training class, for assisting voters on Election Day. Bilingual workers receive an additional \$10 stipend.
