As you are aware, the site of the former Palos Verdes Landfill has been the subject of great interest to dog park enthusiasts. The City of Palos Verdes Estates understands that the County of Los Angeles Parks and Recreation Department will be considering alternatives for development of this County-owned property located in the City of Rolling Hills Estates.

Following the City of Rolling Hills Estates' recent expression of support for use of a small portion of the former landfill property to site a dog park, the Palos Verdes Estates City Council, at its July 13, 2010 regularly scheduled meeting, authorized forwarding to your office this letter of support for siting a dog park on a portion of the former Palos Verdes Landfill property.

In closing, we very much value the relationship that we have both with the County of Los Angeles and with Rolling Hills Estates – the host city of the former landfill site.
